

Grins & Fins Indoor Water Park – Safety Rules & Regulations

Our goal is to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all Grins & Fins Water Park guests. Please review the following rules and regulations. At check-in, you will be required to sign a **GUEST CODE OF CONDUCT WAIVER FORM**.

- Guests using the water park facilities agree to comply with **all** water park policies, rules, and regulations.
- Guest key cards will allow the key holder access to the water park, arcade, concession area, and fitness room besides their guest room. **Monitoring you child/children and other guests using your key card remains your responsibility.**
- **Wristbands are required** for all water park access. Wristbands are distributed by the front desk upon hotel check-in and are color-coded to reflect guest departure date. One wristband will be issued per guest, per day. Lost wristbands will be replaced for a \$5.00 fee. Adjustments to wristbands must be done at the front desk, no exceptions. Guests giving their wristband(s) to someone else for entrance to the water park will be blocked from water park use without refund. **Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult at all times and will not be issued a wristband without adult accompaniment.**
- Proper bathing attire (**a standard and approved swimsuit**) is required – basketball shorts, sports bras, etc. DO NOT QUALIFY as approved swim attire. Hotel guests using the water park must wear proper attire including footwear in all public places of the hotel.
- **Children under the age of three are required to wear a water resistant swim diaper which are available for purchase at the Front Desk.**
- The use of personal floatation devices is encouraged but at your own risk.
- We suggest removing any loose jewelry before entering the water. The Holiday Inn Express, Staybridge Suites and Grins & Fins Water Park are not responsible for any lost or stolen property.
- **No food or beverage will be permitted in the pool area.** Chewing gum or tobacco in the pool area is not allowed. Hard plastic and glass containers are not allowed in the pool area.
- The Grins & Fins Water Park is fully staffed with lifeguards during the *Splashdown Express* water slide operational hours only.

Rules & Regulations

1. Use of the facility is at your own risk. We are not responsible for accidents or injuries.
2. **NO DIVING** at any time in any of the pools.
3. A bather using the facility must take a cleansing shower before entering the pool enclosure. A bather leaving the pool to use the toilet must take a second cleansing shower before returning to the pool enclosure.
4. Bandages must be removed before entering the water. Please notify staff of any pre-existing medical conditions.
5. A person having a communicable disease transmissible by water is prohibited from using the pool. A person having any exposed sub-epidermal tissue, including open blisters, cuts, or other lesions is prohibited from using the pool. A person who has or has had diarrhea within the last two weeks caused by an unknown source or from any communicable or fecal-borne disease is prohibited from using the pool
6. Spitting, spouting water, blowing the nose or discharging bodily wastes in the pool is strictly prohibited.
7. Running, boisterous or rough play or excessive noise is forbidden in the pool area, showers or dressing rooms.
8. Common towels, combs, brushes and drinking cups are prohibited. Private swim suits and towels should be cleaned and dried after each use.
9. No person may take food and drink inside the pool enclosure.
10. Dogs and other animals are not allowed in the pool area.
11. All children and non-swimmers must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult supervisor.

MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ADMITTANCE TO, OR EJECT FROM THE POOL PREMESIS, ANY PERSONS FAILING TO COMPLY WITH ANY OF THE HEALTH AND SAFETY RULES AND REGULATIONS.

Water Slide Rules

1. No running, standing, kneeling, tumbling, or stopping on flumes or in tunnels.
2. No head first sliding at any time.
3. The use of a slide while under the influence of alcohol or impairing drugs is prohibited.
4. Only one person at a time may travel the slide.
5. Obey instructions of staff at all times.
6. Keep all parts of the body within the flume.
7. Leave the splash pool promptly after exiting from the slide.
8. You must be 48" tall **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
9. Registered guests only.
10. Swimsuits only.
11. Form waiting line on the deck. Not the stairs.
12. Do not slide until the landing area is clear and the attendant says to start.
13. Slide only in the sitting position or lying on your back with feet pointed toward the water, arms clasped across chest.
14. Do not attempt to stop, walk, or climb back up the slide.
15. Water is only 3' 6" deep.
16. **Warning-Pregnant women and riders with heart, back, or other medical condition should not use this slide without first consulting their physician.**

**WARNING – Failure to follow slide rules can result in serious injury to yourself and others.
Attendant may prohibit slide use by persons who violate slide rules.**

Water Play toy Rules

1. An adult must supervise children under six years old.
2. No running on or around the water play unit.
3. No head first sliding on slides or in tunnels.
4. No climbing on pipes or handrails.
5. No hanging or swinging on pull ropes.

SPA

-CAUTION-

- Elderly persons and those suffering from heart disease, diabetes or high blood pressure should consult a physician before using the spa pool.
- Persons suffering from a communicable disease transmissible via water may not use the spa pool. Persons using prescription medications should consult a physician before using the spa.
- Individuals under the influence of alcohol or other impairing chemical substances should not use the spa pool.
- Bathers should not use the spa pool alone.
- Pregnant women should not use the spa pool without consulting their physicians.
- Persons should not spend more than 15 minutes in the spa in any one session.
- **Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied and supervised by at least one responsible adult over the age of 18 years at all times.**
- **Children under the age of five years are prohibited from bathing in a spa or hot tub.**
- Running or engaging in unsafe activities or horseplay in or around the spa pool is prohibited.
